

GenPole Flagpole

NOTE: A generator should not be run in or in close proximity to a living area. Allow components to cool after running generator before touching.

IMPORTANT: We highly recommend keeping the first couple feet of a silicone tubing run fairly straight to reduce heat buildup and extend the life of the tubing. A tight bend will cause a kink and premature failure.

Installation:

- 1. Place flagpole into holder that is already secured.
- 2. Attach top flag to the top clips, attach bottom flag to the remaining clips.
- 3. Slide top section apart and use arrow on the top section to orient the stainless button to the hole. Repeat each section until at full height.
- 4. Slide polycarbonate locking ring over the bottom button of the flagpole. This helps to ensure exhaust is transmitted out of the top of the GenPole.
- 5. Remove plug on generator attachment port.
- 6. Attach exhaust components to the generator attachment port.
- 7. Start generator, enjoy!

Removal (while pole is still secured in a base):

- 1. Once cooled, lower one section as a time by pushing stainless buttons and slide pole sections together. This can be done with the pole in the vertical position.
- 2. Remove flags.
- 3. Reinsert plug into generator attachment port (this is intended to prevent insects from inhabiting the tube when used without generator).
- 4. Wipe off any exhaust condensation from the inside of the base. It is normal for water to be present at the base during operation.
